Your 8(a) Business Plan has been approved. For reporting purposes your program year begins, May 1, 2009 to April 30, 2009. Your program term ends May 1, 2018.

You will be required to review this plan with your assigned Business Development Specialist (BDS) annually. Prior to the end of the current program year, you will be sent an 8(a) Annual Update Form for completion.

Your firm's approved primary North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS) Code is 423910. The U.S. Small Business Administration approves the primary NAIC Code. Your firm may be awarded contracts under other NAICS Codes as long as the firm is qualified to perform.

Per 13 CFR 124.509(i)(2), "8(a) and non 8(a) revenue will be monitored using annual financial statements, submitted to SBA within 90 calendar days (120 days for audited statements) from the end of the firms fiscal year." Financial statements must segregate revenue as 8(a) and non-8(a); and revenue should be identified as either competitive or non-competitive. You must also provide an annual report of all non-8(a) contracts, options and modifications reflecting price executed during the program year within 30 days from the end of the program year."

We also encourage you to utilize all of the counseling programs available to you including the Service Corps of Retired Executives (SCORE), the Small Business Development Centers (SBDCs) and the SBA/Bell Atlantic Business Information Center (BIC).
